O Prabhupada, Your words are always pure. Of course when You speak my message then only will My message enter their hearts.

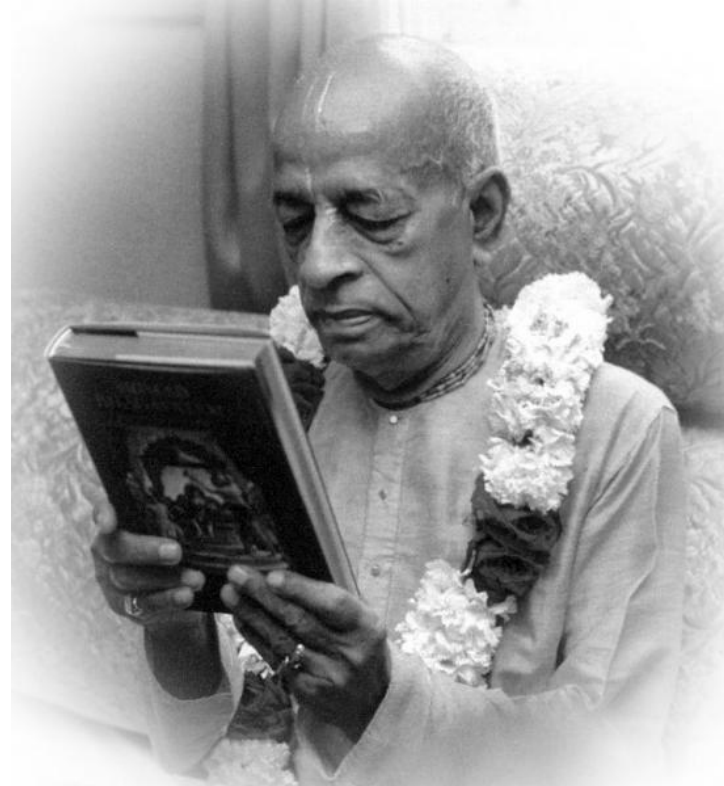
